

REDUCE MISHANDLED BAGS AT A MAJOR AIRPORT HUB?

THE CHALLENGE

Replace an obsolete, saturated baggage system while keeping Geneva Airport operational throughout more than six years of works, alongside adjacent projects and complex building interfaces.

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THE SOLUTION

The Baggage Logistics Center (BLC) project combines centralised sorting with a complete IT/SCADA overhaul and operational reorganisation. Eight EDS Standard 3 units address security compliance.

BIM coordination and rigorous VABF/VSR testing support delivery under a tight schedule and demanding construction constraints.

THE RESULT

Sorting capacity rises from 3,500 to 5,200 bags per hour, with 110 check-in counters and over 10 km of conveyors. The project aims to support 25 million passengers a year by 2035.
