JAPAN

In April 2016, VINCI Airports took over the operations of Kansai and Osaka international airports.

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

On April 6, 2016, VINCI Airports took over the operation of six airports in the Dominican Republic.

CAMBODIA

VINCI Airports has supported the country's economic growth for over 20 years by developing the activities of its three international airports: Phnom Penh, Siem Reap and Sihanoukville.

PORTUGAL

VINCI Airports has been designated in 2013 to manage 10 airports in Portugal, among which Lisbon international hub .

CHILE

On April 21, 2015, the consortium Nuevo Pudahuel, formed by VINCI Airports, Aéroports de Paris and Astaldi was awarded a 20-year concession for the international airport in Santiago.

FRANCE

VINCI Airports network expanded with two regional airports and now includes 12 airports in the country.

UK

In 2018, Belfast airport and in 2019 Gatwick airport joined the VINCI Airports portfolio.

In 2018, VINCI Airports took over the operation of the international airport of Salvador and in 2022 integrated the airport of Manaus and the six other platforms in the region.
